## Abridged Checklist for Facilities that have Achieved ISO 45001 Certification

Facilities that have achieved certification to the *ISO 45001:2018 Occupational health and safety management systems* — *Requirements with guidance for use* will have already demonstrated that they meet many of the criteria in the *TSM Safety and Health Protocol.* This abridged checklist identifies additional TSM criteria required to meet Level A, AA, and AAA requirements.
