This letter is to attest that IAMGOLD has a process in place for the President and CEO to verify the information provided to the Mining Association of Canada (MAC) with respect to the company's Towards Sustainable Mining (TSM) Performance Indicators. We are pleased to provide the following assurance statement regarding the verification of our TSM performance in 2014.

The TSM Verification Process included an independent review performed by *Environmental, Safety Consulting and Auditing Firm - Guy Auclair*. The external verification was done for our three (3) mine sites (including 2 international sites) as well as our head office in Toronto. The verifier measured the company's self-assessed TSM performance indicators against the requirements of MAC's TSM standards.

Significant global compliance to all protocols had been observed for a high performance rated. The independent verifier statement concluded IAMGOLD inc mines sites under TSM (Toward sustainable mining) protocols are conformed to all protocols required by Mining Association Canadian (MAC).

The external verifier concluded the following:

- A total of six (6) protocols and seventy two (72) indicators for three (3) mine sites and one (1) head office have been considered for the verification TSM scope.

All mine sites of IAMGOLD comply with minimum of A indicator as bottom line requirements.

- 65 indicators criteria were maintained
- 5 indicators criteria were downgraded
- 2 indicators criteria were upgraded

The external verification was sent to the MAC in April 2015.
