According to MAC - TSM methodology, the TSM Tailings Verification was conducted on a representative sample of facilities. The Independent Verifiers selected and focused on Lagoon D (active facility) and Lagoons A, B, and C (closed facilities), as they were considered to be a representative sample for the verification process.
Summary of the verification activities	The Independent Verifiers reviewed over 100 documents provided by the operation, conducted interviews (either in person or by videoconferencing) with 12 operational staff and senior managers from different areas of the operation, Coal BU and Teck Corporate managers and representatives, participated in meetings, presentations, and discussions on site with site operational personnel, as well as conducted interviews with the RTFE, EOR, and the ITRB Lead.
